BY-LAW 267 CONCERNING DOGS
IN ORDER TO COMPEL OWNERS
AND/OR CUSTODIANS OF
DANGEROUS DOGS TO
HAVE THEIR DOGS WEAR A
MUZZLE**

By-law 267 entitled: 'By-law concerning dogs' is further amended as follows:

Article 1.

The following paragraph shall be added before Article 1 of By-law 267:

Definitions:

"Muzzle" means a humane fastening or covering device of adequate strength over the mouth to prevent a dog from biting.

"Chief of police" means any station commander within the Agglomeration of Montreal and/or duly authorized employees, subordinate to said Chief and employed by said agglomeration or the Chief of Public Security for the City of Côte Saint-Luc and/or duly authorized employees subordinate to said Chief and employed by the said City.

"Dangerous dog" means a dog which:

- a) has a propensity, tendency, or disposition to attack, bite, threaten, or injure, with or without provocation, any persons, property or other animals, or
- b) with or without provocation or physical injury, attacks, bites, or threatens any person, property, or domestic animal, or
- c) has been trained for dog fighting or to attack upon a command.

Article 2.

Article 7 of By-law no. 267 shall be amended by adding the following paragraph:

- 7.e) The neglect by the owner and/or custodian to have his Dangerous Dog wear a Muzzle when on any public property throughout the City of Côte Saint-Luc;

Article 3.

Article 8 of By-law No. 267 entitled "BY-LAW CONCERNING DOGS" is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:

- 8) In the event that the owner and/or custodian of a Dangerous Dog fail(s) to comply with the obligation to muzzle said dog, he shall be liable to the fine hereinafter provided.

Article 4.

This by-law comes into force on according to the law.
