WHEREAS Council may make By-Laws to license and  
regulate the keeping of dogs;

It is ordained and enacted by By-Law No. 1220  
entitled "BY-LAW AMENDING ARTICLES 7 AND 12 OF BY-LAW NO. 267  
ENTITLED 'BY-LAW CONCERNING DOGS', TO CONTROL CERTAIN NUISANCES  
THAT EXIST AND TO INCREASE THE FINE THEREFOR", as follows:

By-Law 267, entitled "BY-LAW CONCERNING DOGS",  
is hereby further amended as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Article 7 of By-Law No. 267 entitled "BY-LAW CONCERNING DOGS" is hereby repealed and replaced by the following:


"The facts, circumstances and acts detailed hereinafter constitute 'nuisances' and are, as such prohibited and every custodian who himself causes such a 'nuisance' or whose dog acts so as to constitute such a 'nuisance' violates the present By-Law:

- a) any dog, which may be a source of danger or annoyance through its viciousness, or by habits such as biting, barking, howling, or rooting up flowers, grass, or disturbing garbage cans, etc., or by disease or otherwise;
- b) the presence of a dog in public parks and playgrounds;
- c) the presence of a dog on any grounds belonging to the City except for public roads and sidewalks or on private grounds without the consent of the owner or occupant of the grounds;
- d) the neglect by the custodian to clean by all appropriate means forthwith every public or private ground soiled by faeces of a dog."


ARTICLE 2. Article 12 of said By-Law No. 267 is hereby amended by replacing the words "forty dollars (\$40.00)", in the tenth line thereof, by the words "one hundred dollars (\$100.00)".


