BY-LAW TO FURTHER AMEND BY-LAW NO.267 ENTITLED "BY-LAW CONCERNING DOGS", TO ENABLE THE MUNICIPALITY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH ANY PERSON OR BODY TO AUTHORIZE SUCH PERSON OR BODY TO ISSUE DOG LICENSES AND ENFORCE ANY BY-LAW CONCERNING ANIMALS.

At a Regular Monthly Meeting of the Municipal Council of the City of Côte Saint-Luc, held at the City Hall, 5801 Cavendish Boulevard, on December 21, 1992, at which were present:

WHEREAS by and in virtue of article 412 (19.1)(e), of the Cities and Towns Act, the City may make a by-law to enable to City to enter into agreements with any person or body to authorize the person or body to collect the cost of animal licenses and enforce any municipal by-law concerning animals;

WHEREAS it would be in the interest of the City to adopt such a by-law and to enter into such an agreement with respect to the enforcement of the City by-laws concerning dogs;

IT IS ENACTED AND ORDAINED AS BY-LAW NO. ENTITLED "BY-LAW TO FURTHER AMEND BY-LAW 276 ENTITLED "BY-LAW CONCERNING DOGS" TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH ANY PERSON OR BODY TO ISSUE DOG LICENSES AND ENFORCE ANY BY-LAW CONCERNING ANIMALS", as follows:

ARTICLE 1. By-Law 267, as amended from time to time is hereby again amended by inserting the following articles immediately after Article 14 thereof namely:

"ARTICLE 15. The City may at any time and from time to time enter into agreements with any person or body to authorize such person or body to collect the annual license fees imposed in virtue of article 1 hereof, and/or to enforce one or more of the other provisions of this by-law as Council may direct.

ARTICLE 16. Any agreement entered into in virtue of the preceding article shall be in writing.

ARTICLE 17. The City may authorize the Mayor or Acting Mayor and the City Clerk or any assistant

clerk, to sign any such agreement for and on behalf of the City.

ARTICLE 18. The person or body with whom or with which the City enters into any such agreement, and his or its employees are deemed to be municipal officers or employees for the purposes of collecting license fees and enforcing the provisions of the present by-law."

ARTICLE 2. The present By-Law shall come into force according to Law.
