AND RESOLVED:

WHEREAS the Council may make by-Laws to secure peace,  
order, good government, health, general welfare and improvement  
of the municipality provided such by-laws are not contrary to the  
Laws of Canada or of this Province;

WHEREAS the Council may make By-Laws to appoint all officers and men necessary for the extinction and suppression of fires, the protection of property from fire and the prevention of accidents by fire;


WHEREAS it is in the public interest that injuries to persons and damages to property by fire be prevented;


THAT IT BE ENACTED AND ORDAINED by a By-Law of the City Council and it is hereby enacted and ordained subject to all the approvals required by the Law as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Article 2-10 of By-Law 626 concerning fire prevention is hereby amended so that it shall henceforth read as follows:

"ARTICLE 2-10. For every high hazard occupancy (area) in a building or part of a building, provided or not with a standpipe system and in all areas of basements of apartment and commercial buildings, an automatic sprinkler system shall be installed according to the standards of the Canadian Underwriter's Association, as recommended by the National Fire Protection Association."

ARTICLE 2. The present By-Law shall come into force according to the Law.
