**BY-LAW 110-3 FURTHER
AMENDING BY-LAW 110
RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND
PUBLIC SAFETY IN ORDER TO
MODIFY FINES FOR PARKING
WHERE PROHIBITED, THE
OVERNIGHT PARKING
RESTRICTIONS AND PARKING
RESTRICTIONS PERTAINING TO
TEMPORARY SIGNAGE**

It is enacted and ordained by By-Law 110-3 entitled: "By-law 110-3 further amending By-law 110 relating to traffic and public safety in order to modify fines for parking where prohibited, the overnight parking restrictions and parking restrictions pertaining to temporary signage" as follows:

Traffic By-Law No. 110 in the territory of Côte Saint-Luc is hereby amended with the following articles:

Article 1: Article 17 of By-Law 110 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

"No one may park a vehicle on a public street, or place or thoroughfare between 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m."

Article 2: Article 16 of By-law 110 is hereby amended by adding article 16.B:

"16 B. Notices of infraction may be issued and an authorized person be empowered to move a motor vehicle when, the owner or driver of the vehicle has been parked 4 hours or more, subsequent to the posting of temporary No Parking signs."

Article 3: Schedule "D" referred to in By-law 110 shall hereinafter be amended to read as follows:

To have parked in the following described manner constitutes an infraction.

Article 4

Article 18 of By-law 110 is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

"Except at locations where parking is already prohibited or limited, no vehicle shall be parked on any street or public place for a period longer than twelve hours for any given period of time".

Article 5: This By-Law comes into force on June 1st, 2006.


