BY-LAW NO. 1230

BY-LAW AMENDING ARTICLE 27 OF BY-LAW
NUMBER NO. 110, RELATING TO TRAFFIC
AND PUBLIC SAFETY, TO PROHIBIT
CROSSING OF VEHICLES OVER SIDEWALKS
AND PARKING OF SAME BEYOND THE CURB
LINE.

WHEREAS it is in the interest of the City and
of its citizens to amend By-Law No. 110 relating to traffic
and public safety to prohibit crossing of vehicles over
sidewalks and parking of same beyond the curb line;

THAT IT BE ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY A BY-LAW OF the City Council and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:


ARTICLE 1. Article 27 of By-Law 110, relating to traffic and public safety, is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:

"ARTICLE 27. No driver of any vehicle shall drive the same over a sidewalk and no vehicle shall be parked beyond the curb line except where there already exists an approved, accessible depressed sidewalk ramp serving a driveway established in accordance with section 7-5-3, 7-5-5 and 7-5-6 of By-Law 1150, or where there also already exists a similar ramp serving a parking area likewise established in conformity with section 7-2-2 of by-law 1150."

ARTICLE 2. The present by-law shall come into force according to Law.
