IT IS ORDAINED AND ENACTED by By-Law No. 1742,
entitled "BY-LAW TO FURTHER AMEND BY-LAW 110, ENTITLED
"BY-LAW RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND PUBLIC SAFETY", WITH
REGARD TO ARTICLES 1 & 13", as follows:

By-Law 110, entitled "BY-LAW RELATING TO TRAFFIC
AND PUBLIC SAFETY", as amended from time to time, is hereby
further amended as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Article 1, as amended by By-Law 1695, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following:

"26. Median: A concrete, paved or grassy strip dividing those lanes of a roadway permitting the flow of traffic in two different directions."

ARTICLE 2. Article 13 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:


"(7) Along a median."
